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## Loving God and the Sojourner Deut. 10:12-22

**Focus:** Based on the worth and work of God, His people should respond in repentance and a faith that leads to loving the loveless.

(Pick a number or two, as best serves your group, and dig into it....wrestling with the theology and then driving it to repentance, faith and action. Don't try to do all of them!)

1) How are verses 12 and 13 a summary of Deuteronomy, the OT and the Bible as a whole? Do you agree or disagree? Why or why not? How does/ should this play out in everyday life?

2) How do we "BEHOLD" God and why is this crucial for the Christian Faith? What is the danger in not "beholding" God? How will you cultivate a lifestyle of "beholding" God?

3) How do you "Circumcise Your Heart?" How do you reconcile Deuteronomy 30:6 with Deut. 10:16? Why is this Good News? How does this point us to Christ? What callouses on your heart need circumcising?

4) What makes a person truly valuable? Discuss the difference between what the world values vs. what God values. Examine your life and see where you align. Now, discuss the difference of loving the categories of "widows, orphans and sojourners" vs loving actual "widows, orphans and sojourners." How can your small group and our church as a whole grow in this? How is this a loving, proper response of worship to what God has done for us in Christ?

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
