for Personal Study and Small Groups 6/3/12

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Deuteronomy 16

Focus: to call the church to embrace our worship gatherings as ways to help us remember God's redemption, rejoice in His provision, and guard our hearts from idolatry, all as acceptable worship to God.

Read Deut. 16, 1-18

Since we don't keep these feasts as part of our worship today, what good is studying them?

What themes run through these feasts that reveal themes that should mark our gatherings for worship? (the 3 we covered in the sermon are listed above, but there are a number of others including care for the needy, exalting His name, and giving as we been blessed) Can you support these from the NT?

OPTIONAL: What would be commands and principles that must shape our NT worship gatherings that are found in the NT? (you will need to field ideas and verses throughout the NT)

What do these feasts teach us about God and how He wants to be worshiped by His people?

How does Passover point to Christ? (see 1 Cor. 5.7 for starters)

OPTIONAL: How does the feast of weeks in the OT relate to what happened at Pentecost in Acts 2? (this is not entirely clear. Read Acts 2 and look for connecting points)

Of the themes in these feasts that are to inform our worship today, which one do you most need to grow in?

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
