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## **Deuteronomy 24-25**

Pointing towards Christ ...how the Law shows us Christ

**Focus:** Teaching how the Law points to Christ and Christ fulfills the Law as preparation for communion.

(This is a bit of a tough sermon to discuss due to the scattered verses used. You may simply want to have a more open discussion with people sharing from their notes and spend time worshiping Christ in prayer on that basis. See the last question below for that exercise.)

Discuss what these verses teach us about the Old Testament and Christ: John 5.39; Luke 24.27; Gal. 3.24.

How do the following sets of Laws point to Christ?

- The Offerings (e.g. the burnt offering in Deut. 13.16)
- The Priests (e.g. Deut. 21.5)
- The Laws about cleanness/uncleanness (e.g. Deut. 23.10-11; Lev. 25-27) and leprosy (Deut. 24.8; Lev. 13.45-46)
- The unblemished sacrifices (Deut. 17.1)

What is the significance of Jesus fulfilling the Law (see Matt. 5.17 and Rom. 10.4)? How is this different from abolishing it? How do we fulfill the Law now in light of Rom. 13.8, 10; Gal. 5.14?

How has the Law of Moses pointed you to Christ in a way that makes you want to worship and exalt Him?

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
